

# Wellingborough Town Football Club (2004)

## Code of Conduct

1. This Code of Conduct applies to all Club Members, Officials, and Players of Wellingborough Town Football Club (2004). It also applies to anyone who associates himself or herself to Wellingborough Town Football Club (2004) as a spectator, or visitor to the Clubs Ground or any venue used by the Club.

2. It is against the Code of Conduct to make any racially abusive comments nor indulge in racially abusive actions against any club member, players, officials or supporters.

3. The Club shall take adequate steps to ensure the good behaviour of their members and supporters towards everyone, especially referees and opposing team players.

4 The Club shall take action against anyone who brings the name of Wellingborough Town Football Club (2004) into disrepute.

5. Players and team officials shall at all times accept the referee's decision and not show dissent or react in a provocative or disapproving manner towards a referee at any time.

6. Players and team officials shall not intimidate or assault a referee, another player or a spectator or use foul and/or abusive language or make offensive gestures or hand signals.

7. Players and club officials shall not disclose, or comment upon, any illegal breach of this code nor make any public or press comment, which is detrimental to Wellingborough Town Football Club (2004) or the game of Football in general.

8. Anyone wishing to report any breach of this code should first write to the Chairman of Wellingborough Town Football Club (2004), within 7 days of any alleged incident.

This matter will then be dealt with at the earliest opportunity by WTFC (2004) Disciplinary Committee and the outcome recorded within the clubs official minutes.

It will be the individuals right to appeal to the WTFC (2004) Appeals Committee against any action taken against him or her, provided any appeal is made and received in writing within 7 days of the decision and provided additional information not available at the first hearing becomes available. The decision of the WTFC (2004) Appeals Committee is Final and Binding.

9. Any Club Members, Officials, and Player of Wellingborough Town Football Club found guilty of a breach of the above code, could be expelled from the club for any period (including life) considered appropriate by the Clubs Disciplinary/Appeals Committee. This also applies to anyone who associates himself or herself to Wellingborough Town Football Club (2004) as a spectator or visitor to the clubs ground.
